TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C175 HIGH STREET KEMPSFORD

Gloucestershire County Council, as traffic authority, intends to make an Order under the relevant provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) to temporarily close part of the C175 High Street Road from the properties known as Cross Tree Flats to the property known as Number 2 High Street for a distance of approximately 100 metres. The reason for the closure is for works for the installation of a new service connection. The road is expected to be closed from the 22nd April 2024 until 26th April 2024 only or until the works have been completed, whichever is the later.
